

GRADUATION PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

SUMMARY OF GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To graduate with a dogwood diploma, students must earn a minimum of 80 credits, of which:

- 48 credits come from required courses (12 courses in total)
- 12 credits must come from grade 12 level elective courses (3 courses)
- 4 credits from the required Graduation Transitions program
- 16 remaining credits from either grade 11 or 12 elective choices (4 courses)

ELECTIVE COURSE CREDITS

Students must earn a minimum of 28 credits of elective choices. 12 credits (3 courses) must be at the grade 12 level. Neither Communications or English 12 count as one of these courses.

GRADUATION TRANSITIONS: Graduation Transitions is a requirement for graduation. Students will work on this requirement in their grade 10, 11 and 12 years.

- * Social Studies 11, Civics 11, or First Nations Studies 12 can be used for this credit
- ** Physics 11, Chemistry 11, Biology 11, Earth Science 11 or Sustainable Resources 11
- *** Apprenticeship & Workplace Math 10 OR Foundations and Pre-calculus 10
- **** Apprenticeship & Workplace 11, Foundations 11, or Pre-Calculus 11
