

GRADUATION PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

SUMMARY OF GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To graduate with a dogwood diploma, students must earn a minimum of **80 credits**, of which:

52 credits come from required courses (13 courses in total)

12 credits must come from grade 12 level elective courses (3 courses)

16 remaining credits from either grade 11 or 12 elective choices (4 courses)
