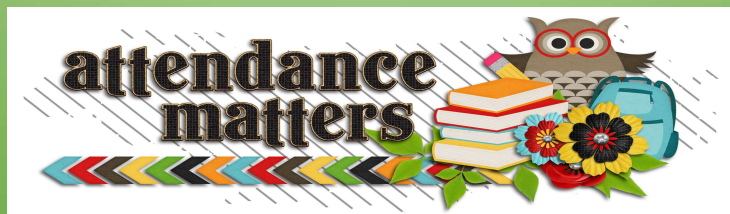
School Dance

Work Experience: Are you in Grade 11 or 12? Do you have a part-time job and want to earn 4 credits? Packages are available, please stop by room 11A. A reminder to those who wish to sign up, you must be able to meet the minimum 100 hr requirement before June 1, 2024. Please drop completed packages off in room 11 A. (Hours will not start accumulating until your package is signed and handed in). For any student who has already handed in the application, please stop by Room 11 A to check in with Mr. Cox about your progress in Work Experience. You must complete the 100 hours and required documents to get the credit for the program. All paperwork Must be handed in by June 1, 2024.
