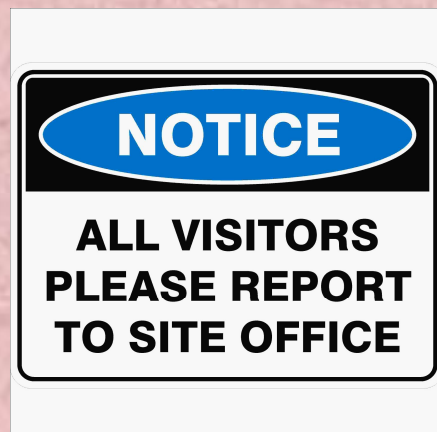

The budget funds all the activities within our school district and is prepared to support the strategic priorities and commitment to students. The Strategic Plan 2022-2027 ‘Engage, Ignite, Empower’ provided feedback on investing in:

The Ministry of Education and Child Care funds our budget through a fixed amount per student. Annual funding is dependent on enrollment across the District plus other factors such as special needs and geographical factors.
