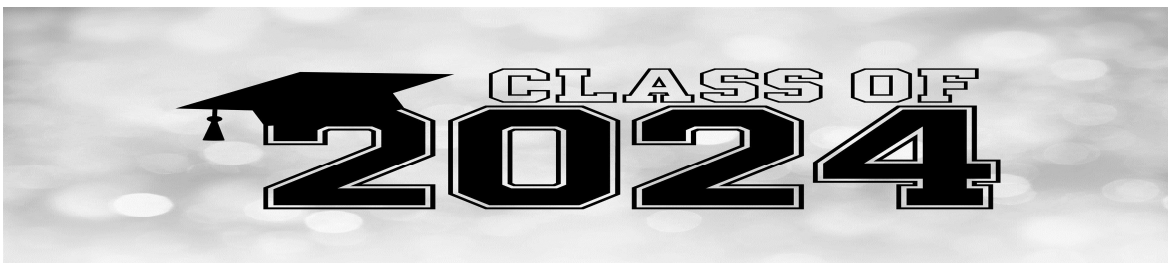
## Schedule for Grad Ticket and Grad Gown Pick-up
