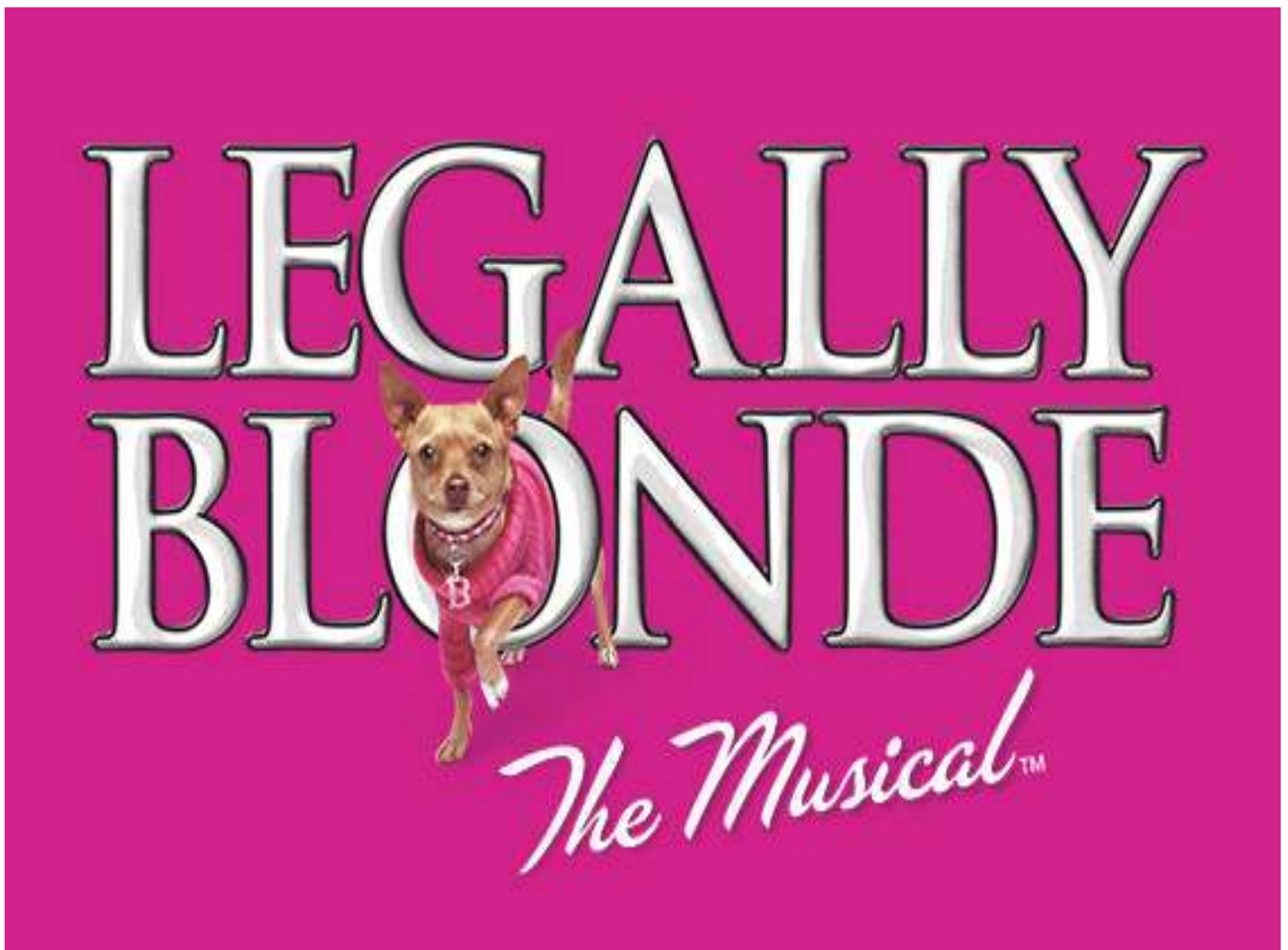

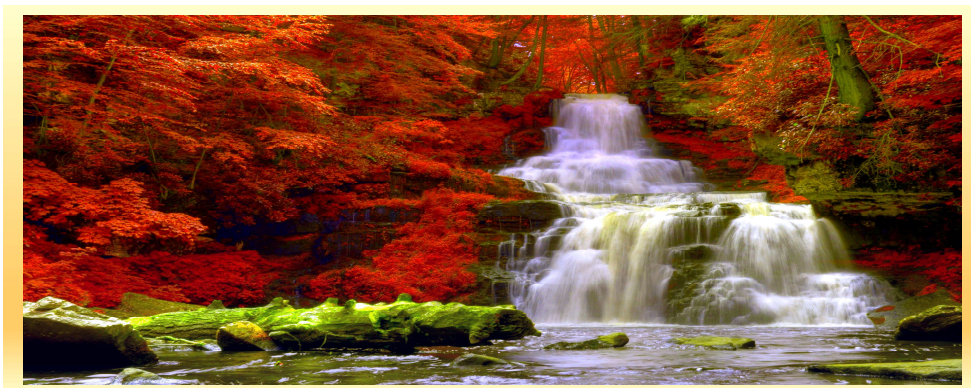
### Dual Credit Students:

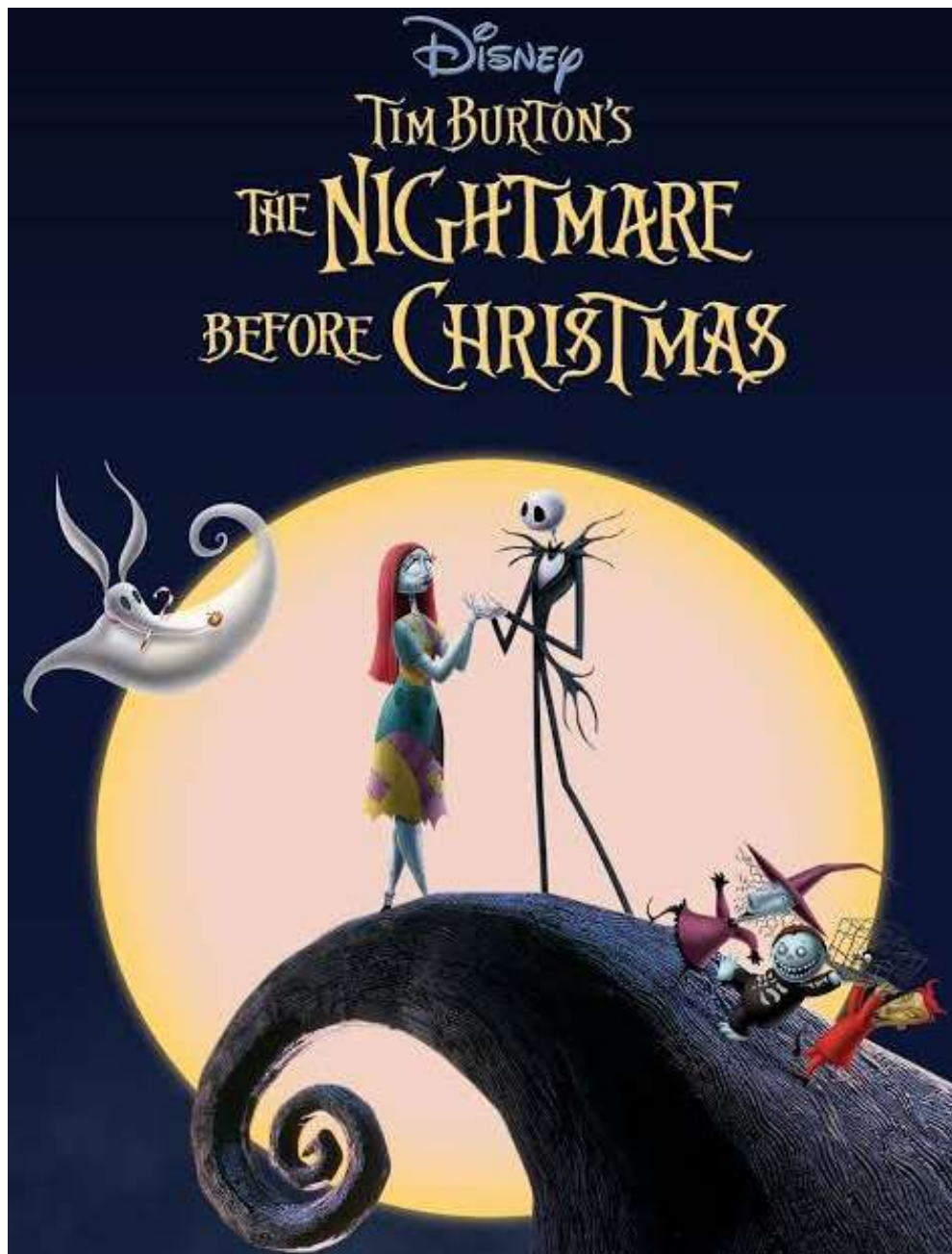
