





Attendance Statistics

Considerable research supports the link between chronic absence and school outcomes. Those children who miss a large portion of the school year are less likely to meet many of the milestones used to determine school success.

Chronic absence is a measure of students who have **missed 10% or more** of the days in which they were enrolled in the school year.


9th 8th	By 9th grade , chronic absence is a better predictor than 8 th grade test scores that a student may drop out of high school.
7th 6th 5th 4th	By 6th grade , chronic absence becomes an early warning sign that a student may drop out of high school.
3rd	
2nd	Students who are chronically absent in
1st K	kindergarten and 1 st grade are less likely to read proficiently by the time they finish third grade

Course performance in the ninth grade was the strongest predictor of student graduation and chronic absence was the <u>strongest predictor</u> of course performance.

Among students who graduate, those who missed ten or more school days during tenth grade had a <u>25 percentage point difference in their post-secondary</u> <u>enrollment rates.</u>

The results of our student attendance survey indicate that we have a significant number of students with chronic absenteeism. Almost 30% of our students reported that they have already missed at least 10 days of school this year. We are working at the school level on strategies to promote good attendance and removal of barriers to learning for all learners. With your support, we hope we can see an improvement in overall student attendance rates.
