Updated Message from RCMP

Police would like to remind riders that various modes of electric transportation (such as e-scooters, e-bikes, e-motorbikes), all have various regulations that apply to them. Parents and guardians should be researching the rules that apply to the items that their children are using to determine if they are being used lawfully.

Another example is the electric kick scooter, which may only be driven in communities in BC which are participating in a [pilot project](#) and they are subject to the rules set by the municipality. In those communities, the riders do not require a license or insurance, however they must be at least 16 years old. Terrace is not one of these participating communities.

There are numerous different fines that may be issued for E-scooter offences, one of which can be issued to a parent or guardian for allowing a person under 16 years of age to operate an electric kick scooter (\$109).

Bikes with pedals that have *motor assist*, where the motor does not propel the bike on its own without pedaling, are considered electric bicycles and do not require licensing". Information about E-bike requirements can be found at [E-bike requirements](#).
