Student Council will be hosting Spirit Week December 15 – December 19. Prizes will be awarded at the end of the week with the main prize being an I-Pad.

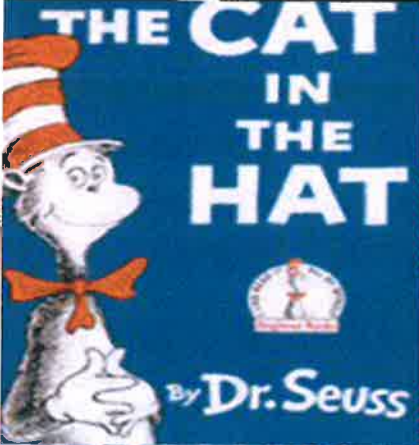

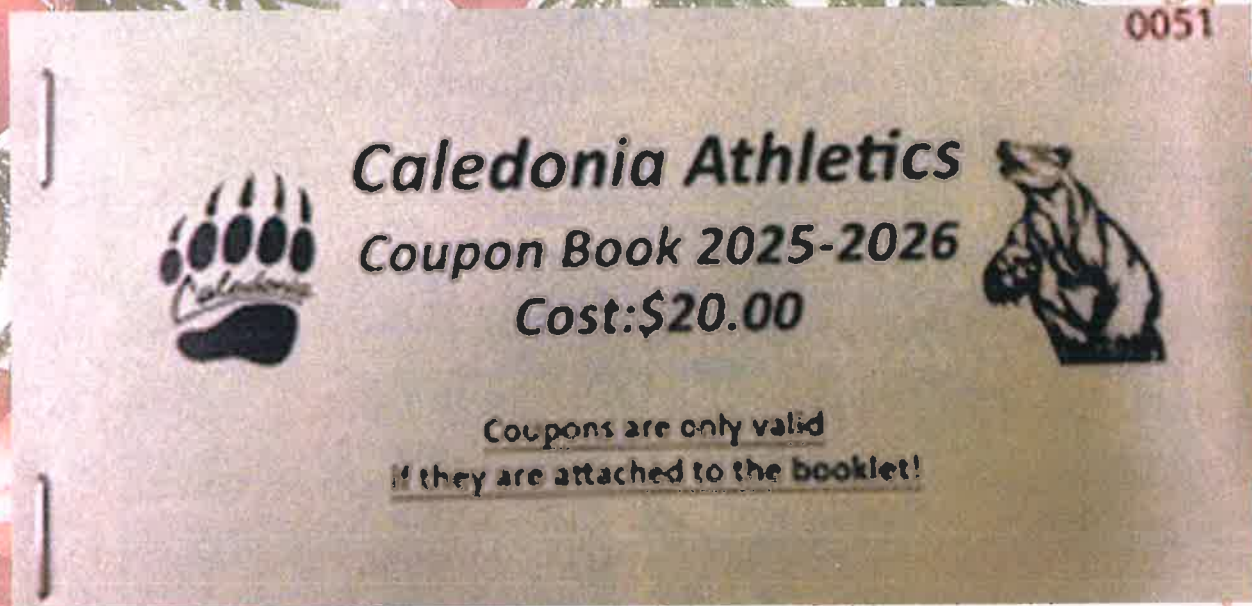

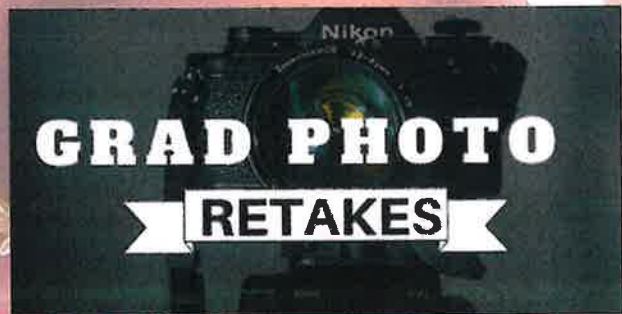
Homework Club
