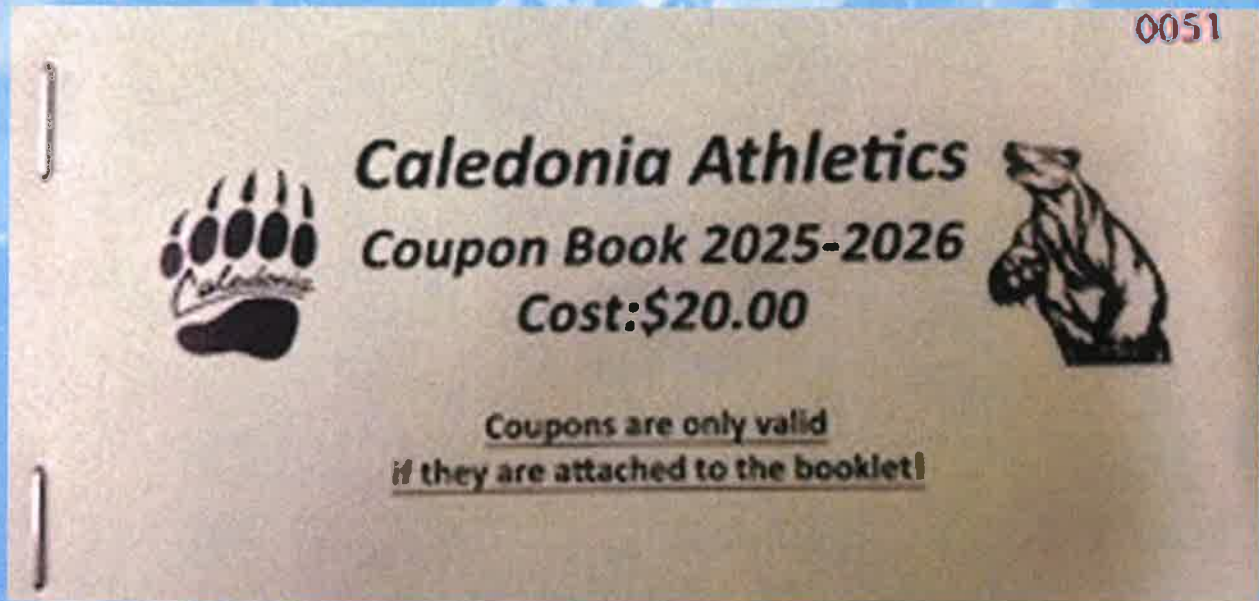

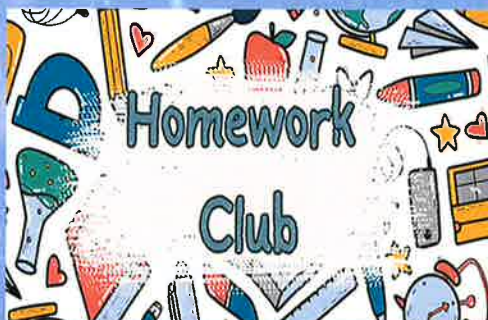
### Kermode Coupon Books
